- I certify that the statements made in this volunteer application are true and have been given voluntarily.
- I understand that I will not be paid for services as a volunteer.
- In consideration of GCHS accepting my application, or my child's, for participation, I agree to release and hold harmless GCHS, its agents and employees from all actions, causes of action, damages, claims or demands, liability, costs and expenses of any nature whatsoever, including without limitation, attorney's fees and disbursements, arising from or occasioned by my participation in GCHS program which I, my child, our heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns may have against the GCHS, and other above-described parties, for all personal injuries known or unknown which I or my child, have or may incur by participating in the above-described activities.
- I understand there are certain risks/dangers inherent in handling animals and I accept these risks.
- I understand that I am responsible for my minor children (under the age of 18).
- I agree that GCHS may photograph my participation in this program and I hereby release any such photographs to GCHS for use in its programs, publications, public relations, and purpose.
- I understand that it is a violation of privacy and breach of confidentiality to publicly discuss or disclose any information I may learn about any animals, previous owners, or situations.
- I will treat all animals, people, and property while at GCHS with respect and courtesy.
- I will conduct myself with courtesy and respect toward the public, other volunteers and staff at all times.
- The Green County Humane Society has made no representations or promises, in order to sign this release.

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DOG WALKING POLICY

(This policy is to be used in conjunction with the Volunteer Policy of the GCHS)

***All volunteers under 18 years of age must have parent's signature on all volunteer and release forms.**

The following colors will be posted on each cage. Staff will get the dog appropriate for your age:

Black Collar - You **must** be 13 years old or older to walk this dog.

Blue Collar - You **must** be 16 years old or older to walk this dog.

Brown Collar - You must be 18 years or older to walk this dog.

Red Collar - **STAFF ONLY** - This dog **MAY NOT** be walked by **any** volunteer.

*Staff makes all decisions as to which dogs can/ cannot be walked by the volunteers.

***DO NOT** walk any dog that is greater than ½ of your weight without staff approval.

***DO NOT** walk any dog out that you are not totally comfortable with.

ALL WALKERS REMEMBER:

- Volunteers may schedule to walk dogs anytime starting after 1:00 pm.
- Volunteers must check in at the reception desk upon arrival; receptionist will notify animal care staff that you are here to walk dogs. Staff will match you with the most appropriate dog and instruct you on any information about the dog. Staff members will take dogs from their kennels and bring to the volunteer; **VOLUNTEERS DO NOT GO INTO THE DOG KENNEL AREAS TO GET DOGS.**
- Only one dog per person is to be walked at a time (with the exception of Team Dog Walkers).
- Only one dog should be exiting/entering kennels at any time. Wait until the aisle and doorways are all clear before exiting/entering the kennels with your dog. The dog beginning its walk has the right of way.
- **KEEP ALL DOGS SEPARATED AND WELL AWAY FROM EACH OTHER WHEN WALKING.** Some of the dogs can be unpredictable or aggressive, especially towards some other dogs.
- Dogs need some time to walk slowly in grassy areas to give them a chance to eliminate. **(DO NOT WALK DOGS ON GRASSY AREA NEAR WATER PLANT.)**
- **ALL WASTE MUST BE PICKED UP WITH PLASTIC BAGS AND DISPOSED OF IN GARBAGE CANS!!!**
- **Allow at least 15 minutes for a walk; longer walks are preferred time permitting. Please** take time to give them some TLC!!! The more human contact they have, the more adoptable they will become.
- If you notice any health concerns or injuries, please be sure to tell the staff member on duty when returning from your walk.

Please feel free to ask for any information or help that you may need. We greatly appreciate your volunteering to help with the animals at the shelter and we want your time here to be a positive experience. Walking time is the highlight of the dogs' day and we also want it to be the highlight of your day. As we get new dogs arriving, some may have problems with fearfulness, unpredictability, anxiety due to their new environment or other problems that are initially unknown. In order to ensure your safety, it is mandatory that you know and follow the dog walking rules, and follow all directives of the GCHS.
